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### **WELCOMING WORDS**


The first quarter of 2024 has begun with outstanding success, from the launch of our Bikepreneur program to the Wheels of Change Gala.

These milestones have demonstrated the incredible support we receive from our partners, individuals, and the community in our mission to enhance lives through bicycles across Tanzania.



**1.Bike2School:** A program that focuses on reducing the long-distance challenges faced by students in rural areas. Currently, the program helps both girls and boys through the distribution of bicycles, maintenance services, awareness campaigns, and the establishment of bicycle clubs in schools.


2.Youth Bike Academy: Develops young cycling talents from the streets to become professional cyclists of tomorrow through theoretical and practical training

**3.Community Bike Forum:** Brings awareness of the benefits of cycling through monthly fun rides and an annual bicycle festival, the Impact Bike Festival.

**4.Bikepreneur:** Creates capacities for youth in bicycle mechanic skills, entrepreneurship, and innovation.

**5.Bikes4Trees:** Aims to combat climate change by promoting the use of bicycles as a means of transportation for community members during tree planting activities. Currently, this program operates in Kahe, Kilimanjaro.

6.Bikes4Change makers: A program aimed at addressing long-distance challenges by tackling four critical needs in rural communities: Education, shelter, healthcare, and permaculture.

#### **1.Bikepreneur Program Launch:**

through an impactful and engaging event held at the WSHA Mega Complex, 7th Floor.

The call for applications officially opened on January 23, 2024, and closed on March 3, 2024. During this period, we received 64 applications from youth interested in joining the Bikepreneur program.

#### 2. Wheels of Change Gala:

Our goal was to expand our support to communities, particularly to protect girls in rural areas from risks such as rape, early marriage, and school dropout, while increasing access to education.

On March 22, 2024, we held an impressive Wheels of Change Gala at the Gran Melia Hotel to raise funds for ABC Impact programs.

We also hosted 75 business owners who joined us in enhancing lives through bicycles.

Through auction items, donations, and pledges, we were able to raise USD 3,500, which will help girls and boys in rural areas continue to use bicycles for their school commutes. 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#### **Challenges** and Learning

#### Challenges

- Low Female Participation: Despite aiming to recruit 60% female and 40% male participants in our Bikepreneur Program, we received very few qualified applications from women, making it difficult to achieve our goal of encouraging female participation in the bicycle industry.
- Overwhelming Applications: We received a large number of applications for the Bikepreneur Program, but due to limited available funding, we were unable to accept all qualified applicants.

- Creating a More Inclusive Environment: There is a need to foster a more favorable environment in the bicycle industry to attract more female participation, particularly in roles like mechanics, where women are significantly underrepresented.
- Establishing Regular Fundraising Events: Hosting the Wheels of Change gala on a regular basis can serve as a consistent fundraising platform for ABC Impact's programs. It also provides an opportunity for companies to showcase their commitment to Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR).
